\$23K IN RELIEF FUNDS AWARDED TO STUDENTS

In response to the COVID-19 related campus closures, the Los Rios Colleges Foundation (LRCF) launched a campaign to raise funds to support our student's emergency needs. Working collaboratively with all four campuses, the COVID-19 Relief Fund is providing resources to our students by:

- Directing aid to our most vulnerable students through the Student Emergency Fund (SEF)
- Providing refurbished computers for students without access to one at home
- Giving grocery gift cards to students who have lost their income
- Providing internet for low-income student

While the LRCF has offered the SEF for many years, in response to the COVID-19 virus, we made an immediate decision to make applying for and receiving an emergency grant easier. We moved to an online application and in the first week alone we saw a 180% increase in applications compared to the entire year last year. We have made incredible progress in raising funds to provide emergency support to our students. As of April 9:

- \$72,040 has been raised by donors, corporations, faculty, and staff
- 223 total donors have contributed, 108 are Los Rios employees
- 45 SEF grants totaling \$23,095 have been awarded
- 166 gift cards have been provided
- Intel Corporation pledged \$25,000
- Wells Fargo has committed \$40,000
- SAFE Credit Union donated \$3,300 worth of gift cards

IT/Tech Tip of the Week: VPN

Many of us are using VPN to connect to our computers on campus. Here are some key tips:

- Don't connect to VPN to use email, Zoom, Skype for Business, Canvas, Web browsers, Google apps or Office 365
- Only connect to VPN when you need access to Peoplesoft, shared network drives, or files that are saved on your remote computer
- Disconnect VPN when you are not actively using it
- **Download the Skype for Business app** to your cell phone to make and receive phone calls using your LRCCD phone number. Use the Skype for Business app directly from your current workstation (and not the VPN window) to prevent audio/microphone issues.
