CANVAS QUICKSTART TRAINING FOR FACULTY

With the uncertainty of where we will be in this crisis by the fall semester, it's imperative that we be preparing to provide services and instruction to students in a fully online environment in the fall, should circumstances warrant it.

A new districtwide resource, [Canvas QuickStart Training](#), is available to guide Los Rios instructional faculty in the basic setup of their fall courses within Canvas. This self-paced training shows how to:

1. Include your contact information.
2. Post your syllabus.
3. Create an announcement or page for your students which informs them about what to expect in the event we must move to remote instruction under emergency conditions.
4. Publish your course.
5. Require students to visit your Canvas course to ensure they are ready to transition if necessary.

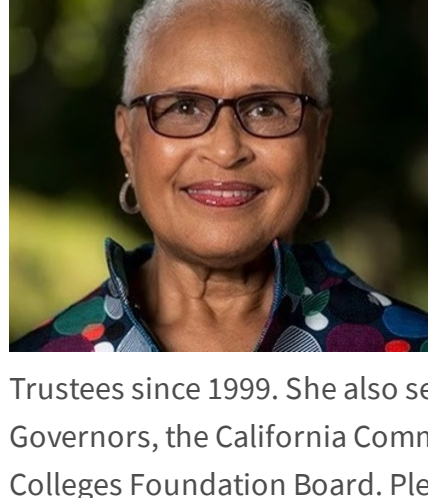
COMUNIDAD SUPPORTS STUDENTS, STAFF

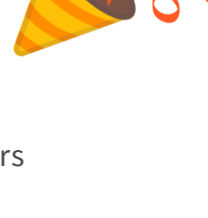
Los Rios Trustee Honored for 20 Years of Service
