SCC GRANTS HELP GRADUATING NURSES FINISH & ENTER WORKFORCE

Sacramento City College recently received \$4,545 from the Foundation for California Community Colleges' First Response Fund to support our nursing students with emergency grants to help support the people who will be our future medical workforce, particularly during the pandemic.

By combining the funding with our Hulda Mae Stone endowment (\$7,350), we were able to award \$350 each to all 34 RN and VN final semester students who applied, to help them pay for their testing and license registration (or other emergency needs, if they have more pressing priorities).

We are pleased to be able to support our students and our community by helping to add vital medical personnel to the workforce!

The webinar will cover two important topics:

- **Budget Information and Update** – Thanks to the stability created by decades of strong leadership from our Board, labor partners and administration, it is easy to take for granted the complexities of how state economic conditions impact the Los Rios budget. Vice Chancellor of Finance and Administration Mario Rodriguez will break down our budget, and he and our college presidents will discuss the impacts of the COVID-19 crisis on our fiscal impact for 2020-21 and beyond.
- **Los Rios Colleges Online** – Before the global pandemic forced an emergency transition to online education at scale in Los Rios, discussions were well underway with our College Presidents and Academic Senate Presidents about a collaborative approach across our colleges for building fully online programs in the future. The team leading this effort will provide an update on those discussions, how the last three months has informed those plans and the urgency of the work moving forward.
