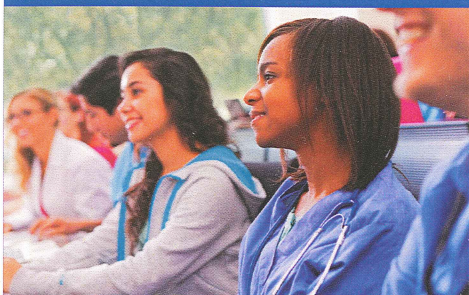
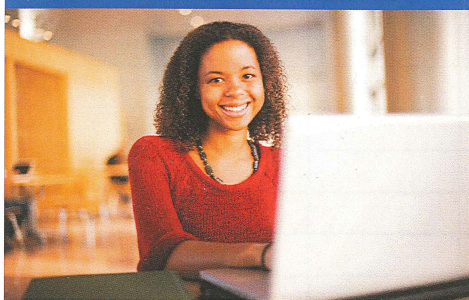
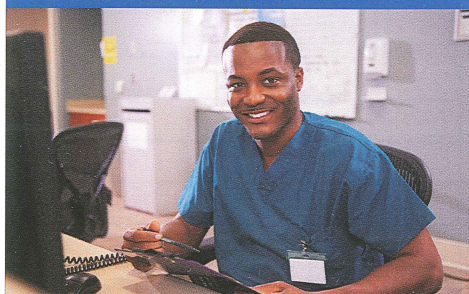

As our population ages, and laws like the Affordable Care Act help more people get access to medical care, the Sacramento region will need people with the skills to provide nursing, therapy, and other health-related services. To meet this demand, we need more trained health care workers. Could a career in allied health be right for you?

Learn the facts about health careers.¹

- Health care organizations in our region will need to expand their operations to serve an additional 960,600 new residents by 2020.
- Sacramento area hospitals and care facilities have entry-level jobs in health care that they can't fill because they need more trained workers.
- A 2014 survey showed projected growth for 11 allied health jobs such as Certified Nursing Assistant, Home Health Aide, Licensed Vocational Nurse, and Respiratory Care Practitioner.

How long are the training programs?

The California Community Colleges in the Sacramento region offer many schedule options – including traditional hours or evenings and weekends – so you can find one that works for you. A typical program takes anywhere from six months to two years. Additionally, some programs offer summer sessions that can shorten the overall duration, to get your qualified and working in your career quickly.
