ESL Assessment test:

- 1. After CCCapply, email the ESL Chair, Prof. Brett Thomas (thomasb@scc.losrios.edu) with full name and ID:
 - Dear Professor Thomas, I would like to start ESL placement. My full name is (First name, Last name), and my wID is (ex: w1234567).

- 2. Prof. Thomas will send clear instructions to their losrios gmail (please emphasize this) to access the assessment test (it will be viewable in their CANVAS).
- 3. Take the test at their convenience (asap)
- 4. Within a week (usually 3-4 days), read the email from Prof. Thomas with ESL class recommendations; talk to a counselor to enroll in these.
- 5. *If enrollment is closed*, please put students in contact with our ESL Ambassadors. We will recommend the ESLLAB and <u>local Adult Ed ESL programs</u> for some English development/practice while they are waiting for the new semester.

ESL Challenges for continuing high level students:

- 1. If a student wants to skip ESL, of course that is their choice. But, remind them that they are not "locked" into the sequence. Students who show the ability to jump a level can ask their instructor to support this challenge process. Almost all legitimate challenges (A students) are granted.
 - a. Legitimate ESL 315 students and lower will really struggle with the reading/writing level in college classes. Any challenge questions students have can be asked to Prof. Thomas.
