A.A./A.S. LOCAL GE PATTERN GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To earn an Associate in Arts/Science degree using local GE pattern below:

1. Complete a minimum of 60 degree applicable units with an overall grade point average of 2.0 or better.
2. A minimum of 12 units must be completed in Los Rios Community College District.
3. Complete all courses for the major with a "C" grade or better AND satisfactorily complete the general education requirements with a 2.0 overall GPA.
Suggestion to counselors: A "C" or better is highly encouraged for English and Math.
4. High unit majors 45 units and more waive Area L7.
5. Students may also use Cal-GETC pattern to complete a local Degree.
6. Students who have confirmed a previous LRCCD degree, and in that degree GE was completed, can have their GE waived for a local degree, this does not include ADTs.
7. EXCEPTION: Students who possess a baccalaureate or higher degree completed at a college or university accredited through a CHEA (Council for Higher Education Accreditation) recognized Regional Accrediting Agency will have satisfied general education and competency requirements for the AA or AS degree. Degrees from accredited institutions outside of the United States will be evaluated on an individual basis.
8. Local GE Pattern per Title 5 began Fall 2025.
