Minimum admission requirements as an upper division transfers must meet the following requirements:

1. Overall 2.0 gpa for all transferable courses and
2. 60 transferable units including a minimum of 30 units from the General Education Breadth-Requirements and
3. Completion of **Area A1, A2 and A3 and Area B4 with a grade of “C-” or better**

**Impacted campuses may require additional criteria for admission.**

The CSU General Education–Breadth Requirements may change each year. It is the student’s responsibility to check with a counselor each year for update if any.

\*\* Courses are listed in more than one section in that area or other areas but can only be used once to satisfy a requirement.

### California State University, Sacramento (CSUS)

1. **Race and Ethnicity Requirement** (CSUS graduation requirement): As of August 21, 1998, CSUS requires 3 units to meet their Race and Ethnicity requirement. The following SCC courses have been approved to meet this requirement. **COMM 325(SP06), ENGLT 334 (SP02), ETHNS 300** formerly SOCSC 300 (**SU05**), **SOC 321 (SU05)**. CSUS continues to have this requirement in addition to AREA F above.
2. **FOREIGN LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT** (CSUS graduation requirement): Effective Summer 2004, the foreign language requirement can be met by one of the following:
  - a. Completion of two semesters (402 level at SCC) of a foreign language at a community college or university, with a grade of "C-" or better **or**
  - b. Completion of the third year of a foreign language with a "C-" grade or better in high school **or**
  - c. Advanced Placement Foreign Language Examination scores of 3, 4 or 5 **or**
  - d. Graduation from a high school (secondary school) where the language of instruction was not English **or**
  - f. See a counselor for other options.

**The following majors (BS degree) are exempt from the foreign language requirement for graduation (Fall 2013). Business Administration, Chemistry (BS only), Computer Science, Engineering, Health Sciences, Kinesiology- Exercise Science concentration, Nursing, Public Health, Physics (BS only), & Recreation, Parks and Tourism Administration.**

3. **ENGLISH COMPOSITION** (CSUS graduation requirement): For students whose catalog is Fall 1992 or later, an additional English composition course is required for graduation (ENGL 20 at Sacramento State). SCC's ENGWR 301, 302 or 303 (CSUGE A3) will be accepted to meet this requirement. If the student is obtaining an Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) English 20 CSUS course requirement is waived, and they will not need to complete SCC's ENGWR 301, 302 or 303, but may choose another course from AREA CSUGE A3.

4. CSU, Sacramento requires a total of 51 units of general education for graduation. Students may choose to take additional units from AREA B at SCC. The remaining 9 units of general education must be upper division and taken at the university level.

##### **Catalog Year Rights**

Option 1- The year continuous enrollment is established at the community college.

Option 2- The year the student begins at the CSU.

Option 3- The year of graduation from the CSU.

##### **CSU General Education- Breadth Requirements Certification**

Partial or full certification of the CSU GE Breadth Pattern can be certified by the Admission and Records office at SCC if **all** coursework was completed at Los Rios Community College District. Otherwise, please see a counselor for certification. Certification is done by area on GE pattern.

**\*\*AREA F** As of Fall 2021, for any student entering a CCC or CSU, without catalog rights to a previous year, this GE area will be a requirement for graduation from CSU. Students must be entering from a CCC or CSU to hold the catalog year prior to Fall 2021, all other students will be required to fulfill the new GE Area F. This course cannot be double counted. This CSU graduation requirement will be mandatory for graduating class of 2024-2025. In order for an ADT or CSU certification to be completed, Area F will be required for those with catalog rights to Fall 2021 and after.

^Area E: As of Fall 2025, students can not use NUTRI 300 to fulfill Area E on the CSU GE pattern. Students who took NUTRI 300 prior to Fall 2025 and have catalog rights to CSU GE pattern prior to Fall 2025 can use NUTRI 300 to fulfill CSU GE Area E.
