Completion of all the requirements in the IGETC will permit a student who transfers from a California Community College to a California State University or University of California campus without the need, after transfer, to take additional lower-division general education courses. All courses must be completed with a "C" grade or better. Students must meet with a counselor to request the IGETC Certification.
