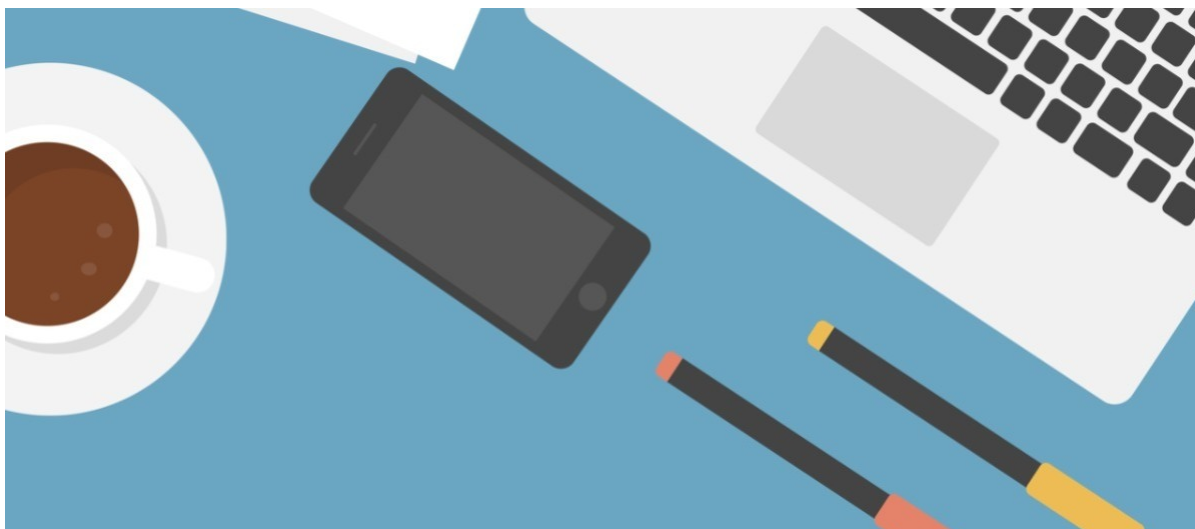
VALENTINE'S DAY AFFAIR POTLUCK
