Issue/Concern:	Faculty/Staff Parking
Describe the issue/concern::	Employees need reliable, predictable parking spaces when arriving on campus to do our jobs, at whatever time of day needed. Faculty (especially post-pandemic) teach from a variety of locations including the main campus, satellite campuses, and home, and often have little time to search for parking between classes; furthermore, parking is needed close to our classrooms/offices so that we can transport the often substantial teaching materials necessary, and so that faculty and staff have safe passage back to parking when teaching at night.
