**Issue/Concern:** College Support for Grants

**Summary of Issue:**

Grant awards have become a growing part of the college's funding stream, to the point where the level of grant activity at the college is surpassing the infrastructure we have to support it. The PRIE Office and PRIE Committee have identified a range of needs. To address these needs the PRIE Committee recommends the creation of a college Grants Committee, in addition to an Operational Memorandum (OM), which will be used to review, process, and determine grant feasibility.

The Charge of the new Grants Committee will be as follows: The SCC Grants Committee supports the college's grant activities by ensuring that grants are aligned with the college's mission, strategic goals, and resource needs; by sharing grant opportunities with the college community; and by reviewing and recommending revisions to grant-related policies and procedures.

**Action Taken:**


- 03/03/2022: Planning, Research, and Institutional Effectiveness (PRIE) Dean Gayle Pitman attended Executive Council to discuss campus issue.
- 04/07/2022: Dean G. Pitman provided an update on campus issue to Executive Council, including information regarding the development of an OM for grant feasibility. Executive Council reviewed and supports the development of the OM and the creation of a new Grants (standing) Committee. Campus Issue closed.
