Issue or Concern: Request to Transition PRIE Advisory Committee to Short-term, Task-Oriented Workgroups

Summary of Issue: The PRIE Advisory Committee does not currently meet the needs of the college, nor does it fully function to support the operations of the PRIE Office. Transitioning to short-term workgroups will promote project-oriented work in support of institutional priorities.

Action Taken:

03/28/25: The campus issue was submitted.

04/03/25: The campus issue was presented at Executive Council. Executive Council discussed with no objections to making the change and a recommendation for President Garcia to write a response directing the change.

11/06/25: President Garcia doublechecked with Interim PRIE Dean Dennis Lee, who agreed with the decision to change the PRIE Advisory Committee to short-term workgroups.
