The Curriculum Committee...

- facilitates the creation of new courses and programs that meet the needs of our students and community.
- reviews and recommends revisions of existing courses and programs.
- assists departments with curriculum review during program review.
- ensures compliance with statewide educational policy including verifying requisites and enforcing distance education standards.
- reviews and recommends courses that satisfy local graduation requirements and general education areas.
- assists departments with adding IDEAA elements to course and program outlines.
- facilitates revision for articulation.
- facilitates converting courses to Common Course Numbered courses.
- provides resources and expertise to faculty developers.
- informs the campus community about any changes in law, education policy, Title 5, or local board policy that will affect Sacramento City College's curriculum.

Describe action items that have been completed.

- Reviewed curriculum for the following departments in program review: Physical Therapist Assistant, Occupational Therapist Assistant, Nursing, Art History, and Humanities.

- 130 programs were revised for the 2025-26 catalog and four programs were revised for the 2026-27 catalog.
- Ten courses were reviewed and approved for the 1/1/25 catalog update including 7 revisions, 1 new to college, and 2 experimental.
- 194 courses were reviewed and approved for the 8/1/25 catalog including 132 revisions, 36 new to district, 16 deletions, 1 experimental, and 9 CCN.
- The courses deleted were pretransfer math and English courses that can no longer be offered because of AB 705/1705.
- 15 courses were reviewed and approved for the 8/1/26 catalog including 1 revision, 5 new to district, 2 new to college, and 7 CCN.
- Many courses and programs are still pending review. This backlog is due to the implementation of Common Course Numbering, Cal-GETC, and the new Local GE pattern.
- Flex workshops were held in Fall 2024 and Spring 2025 to keep the college updated on the many changes due to AB 928, AB 1111, and Title 5 changes.
- Continued to hold the weekly Curriculum Office Hour. This practice has been successful and we will continue next year.
- A new position of CCN coordinator was created to help facilitate the conversion of courses to CCN using the state developed templates.
- All courses and programs that needed edits due to the implementation of CCN, Cal-GETC, and the new Local GE pattern were updated.

Discuss action items that are currently in progress, or that require support or collaboration before they can move forward.

- The SCC Curriculum Handbook is currently being reviewed and revised for approval at the beginning of the 2025-2026 academic year.
- The Tech Review Team continues to create instructions for faculty developers.
- The Tech Review Team continues to discuss timelines to coordinate with outside deadlines for articulation.
- The Equity Subcommittee will resume the important work of helping departments embed IDEAA in course and program outlines.

The Curriculum Committee continues to operate in a hybrid format while complying with the Brown Act. The chair is always in RHN 258. Members using Zoom to attend the meetings list their public location for the agenda. Guests and presenters may attend on Zoom or in person in RHN 258.

The review of curriculum will continue to be prioritized according to need. Most of the curriculum launched this year for program review remains at tech review status. This is because priority needed to be given to converting courses to CCN, implementing Cal-GETC and the new Local GE pattern, and new CTE programs.

While the composition of the committee includes representation from most instructional area, many seats are open.
